

# Turning off Pop-up Blockers

In order to fully use The Mapper on The Providence Plan website you need to allow pop-ups. When using the “flash” feature in The Mapper (the black lightning bolt) a new, smaller screen should appear with a picture and the information requested. If a popup blocker is on, however, this screen will not appear.

Instructions for turning off popup blockers by program/toolbar:

- I. Allowing pop-ups with Internet Explorer
- II. Allowing pop-ups with Mozilla Firefox
- III. Allowing pop-ups with the Google Toolbar
- IV. Allowing pop-ups with the Yahoo Toolbar

## **I. Allowing pop-ups with Internet Explorer**

There are two ways to allow pop-ups in Internet Explorer:

*Option One: enable pop-ups when they are blocked*

1. When you use the flash feature (the black lightning bolt) in The Mapper with pop-ups blocked a light yellow bar will appear under your usual toolbars at the top of the screen.
2. Immediately click on this yellow bar.
3. You will be given options to “**temporarily allow pop-ups**”, which allows one popup to appear, to “**always allow pop-ups from this site...**” and more. Left click on either of these first two options.
4. If you select “temporarily allow pop-ups” the yellow bar should read, “**pop-ups temporarily allowed**”. The flash feature should now work once. You will have to allow pop-ups each time you use the flash feature.
5. If you select “**always allow pop-ups from this site**” the yellow bar will disappear. The flash feature should now always work.

*Option Two: change you popup blocker settings.*

1. Copy the Mapper’s URL at the top of your screen by highlighting it and then right clicking on it and selecting **copy**, or copy it from here:

2. Open the **Tools** menu and click on **Pop-up Blocker** and then **Pop-up Blocker Settings**
3. In the **Pop-up Blocker Settings** window right click in the “Address of Web site to allow” box and **paste** the URL there
4. Click the **Add** button and then the **Close** button

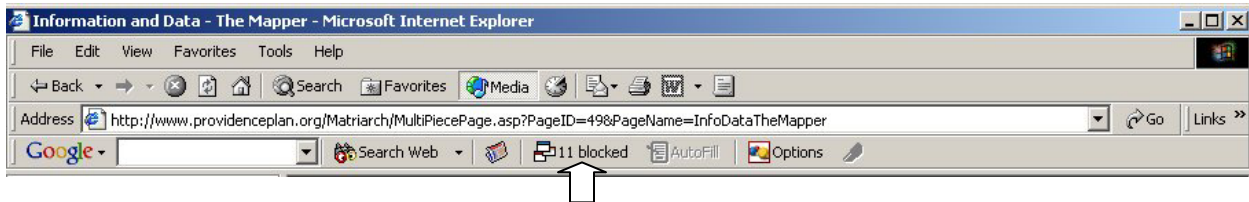
## II. Allowing pop-ups with Mozilla Firefox

1. Highlight then right click and **Copy** The Mapper's URL from the top of the screen or from here: <http://204.17.79.245/website/mapper/viewer.htm>
2. Open the **Tools** menu and select **Options**
3. On the left side of the screen click on **Web features**
4. Click on **Allowed Sites** across from "Block popup windows"
5. In the box under "Address of Website" right click and **paste** The Mapper's URL
6. Click **Allow** then **Ok** and **Ok** again. The flash feature should now work.

## III. Allowing pop-ups with the Google Toolbar

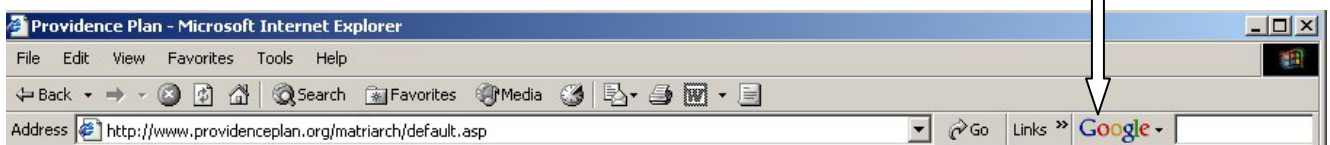
If a white hand with a yellow and red exclamation point appears when you use the flash (black lightning bolt) feature, then the Google popup blocker is on. There are two ways to allow pop-ups depending on how your Google Toolbar appears.

1. If the Google toolbar appears as its own, full-length bar,



then click on the # **blocked** button. It will change to **site pop-ups allowed**.

2. If the Google toolbar appears as a section of your regular toolbar (with only the colorful Google logo after the address bar),



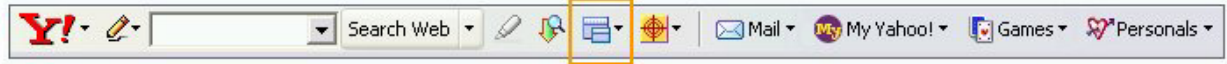
then left click on **Google** and then left click on **options**. A "toolbar options" menu will appear. Uncheck the **popup blocker** and click **OK**.

## IV. Allowing pop-ups with the Yahoo Toolbar

There are two ways to allow pop-ups while using the Yahoo Toolbar.

*Option One: Add the Providence Plan website to your Allowed List*

1. Click on the **Popup Blocker** button.



2. Choose “**Always allow popups from...**”
3. Select The Providence Plan site from the “Source of Recently Blocked Pop-Ups” list and then click **Allow**

*Option Two: Turn off Popup Blocking*

1. Click the **Pop-Up Blocker** button (same as above)
2. Uncheck “Enable Pop-Up Blocker”
3. To enable the popup blocker when you leave the website recheck “Enable Pop-Up Blocker”
